CPC Report
January 2020

In my last report I mentioned that the CPC Committee had been in touch with people who had attended the Trustees Talk in Bozeman in September. We were able to set up meetings with several of them:

- At the end of November, I met with a group of psychologists/psychiatrists/counselors who work with Billings Clinic/Livingston Healthcare/Bozeman Deaconess and who regularly come into contact with patients who have problems with alcohol. At their request, I made a brief presentation on AA. Several people were completely unfamiliar with who we are and how it works, confessing they still thought of AA meetings as places in the worst part of town, where derelicts & desperates attended! I then went on to describe how we feel AA could be an excellent resource for them and provided each of them with a package of relevant brochures, together meeting directories and my contact information. They did ask that we provide them with "newcomer" packets to give to patients who express an interest in knowing more. These are in process.
- Subsequent to this meeting, I was contacted by the Head of Nursing at Bozeman Deaconess asking for a presentation/question and answer session to be made to nursing staff who are most likely to deal with patients who have a problem with alcohol. I am waiting for confirmation from the hospital of a date in early February to meet with these staff.
- This month, I met with two local emergency room doctors in Livingston, with a view to helping them understand how AA members can be reached if someone expresses willingness to have us visit with them. Part of the frustration for these doctors is that they have to wait until the patient has sobered up and agree in writing that they want an AA member to talk to them. By that time, most people just want to get out of the hospital and go home. Both doctors agreed that it had been helpful for them to learn what AA was really like in Livingston - number of meetings, the variety of people who attended etc. so that they can speak more authoritatively about AA as a resource. I have a meeting scheduled with more rotation ER doctors in Livingston at the end of January and have been given contact info for an ER doctor in Bozeman to begin a dialogue there.

In February/March, the CPC Committee will be switching focus to churches. One of our members is putting together a comprehensive list of churches in Gallatin/Park counties. We'll begin by sending introductory letters, followed by phone calls during which we'll hopefully schedule a meeting.
