 - what prevents/discourages you from service-group, district, area?
self/head/laziness; lack of interest/contempt prior to investigation;
lack of time/fear of commitment; fear of failure

- how thorough is GSR communication with group regarding District meetings;
ie: how informed do you feel about what is happening at District? (1-10)

toward service in general? (1-10) 10 (x5); 9
 - how well has GSR helped you understand how service work impacts
the ability of AA to help the still-suffering alcoholic? (1-10)
10 (x4); 7, 6
 - how consistently has GSR announced District events & open service positions
at business meetings? (1-10) 10(x4); 8, 9
at home group meetings? (1-10). 10(x4); 8, 7
